I wanted them to come here as the locomotives are good, and the price low, and as they were in El Paso

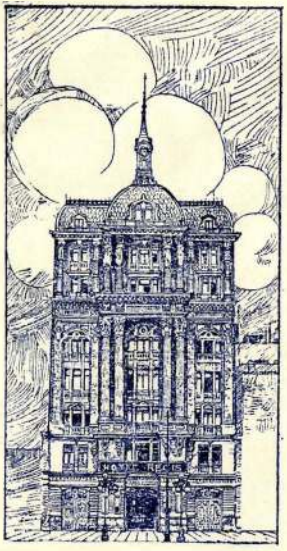
