Dear Green:

I have your very interesting letter of recent date in which, among other things, you give me a brief statement of the plans of the Jews of this country who are affiliated with your association of "New Americans" to seek, through a commission of American citizens of foreign birth, in Ukrania for their kin, or what may be left of their connections after the destruction and dispersal due to the incessant wars in that unfortunate land.

The object of this most humane mission is to rescue the survivors of the war and disorder which has prevailed in that country, and to assist them to start life anew under more agreeable circumstances.

Such a philanthropic scheme surely will meet with the warmest sympathy and support. It is thoroughly characteristic of the Jewish people of this country who have so frequently in the past given such splendid examples of practical sympathy and assistance to their brethren in distress throughout the world.
