We address you, on behalf of Mr. Robert Hind, with reference to the Napier Grass (Elephant Grass) in which you expressed an interest the other day.

So far as we can learn from local authorities there are no restrictions on the shipping of seed or cuttings of this plant to the Republic of Mexico. We are advised to pack the cuttings in wet moss to prevent their drying out in transit, and to send them by express or parcel post. This we are prepared to do on your advising us as to the quantity desired and your further advice as to whether you wish us to make shipment immediately or at such time as will approximately coincide with your return to Mexico.
