Fraijanes II Prison Riot Forces Relocation of High Profile Inmates

1. (SBU) Summary. A riot in Guatemala's Fraijanes II nominally maximum-security prison on November 19 damaged the interior of the prison and all of the inmates were transferred to other locations. The government of Guatemala is working to rebuild the prison, but until then, there remains a heightened risk that several high-profile inmates might attempt to escape. B1 1.4(D) B7(A) 2. (SBU) On November 19, inmates of the Fraijanes II nominally maximum-security prison rioted and took eight prison employees hostage. The prisoners are reported to have rioted to protest limited visitation rights and poor by prison guards. The prison contains over 150 inmates including several B1 high-profile drug traffickers and members of the Zetas, Mara 18, and Mara Salvatrucha (MS-13) gangs. The 1.4(D) prisoners surrendered peacefully to authorities about 24 hours later. During the riot, the prisoners damaged much of the prison, rendering it uninhabitable. No American citizen prisoners were housed in Fraijanes II at the time of the riot, however, the uncertainty of the situation in the days immediately following the incident led the directors of two nearby prisons to ask the Consular Section to postpone previously scheduled visits to AmCit prisoners in those facilities until things had quieted down. 3. (C) Minister of Government (MoG) Mauricio LOPEZ Bonilla speculated to reporters that one of the possible motives of the riot was to have the prisoners transferred to a less secure prison where it would be easier for them to escape. Lopez Bonilla said the government has increased security in the nearby Fraijanes I prison where many of the Zeta and Mara 18 prisoners were transferred.
