Hon. Sir:

The writer is the president of the Mexico Land Company, which has been in operation since 1909. At that time we acquired a tract of land in the State of Vera Cruz, lying across the river to the east from the Station of Perez, now called Pasa del Cura.

We have sold and deed to Americans, 2000 farms out of this tract and have an American Colony of not less than 5,000 families, who are anxious to go down there and make settlement on their lands.

We, a short time ago, acquired from the Bank of Montreal, of Mexico City, a tract of land known as the Buena Vista Hacienda, which contains 20,000 acres and lies one and a half miles south of the Station of Pasa del Cura.

The writer has been over these lands many times and is thoroughly familiar with the conditions in that district. We have been trying to arrange for transportation, but as yet have got no satisfactory reply in regards to it.

If it is not imposing upon you, we would like to have you write us frankly as to whether or not your Government would approve of our coming and whether it would be advisable for us to be in settlement in the month of October. These people are all Americans, (including a few Germans) and are desirous of establishing permanent homes and becoming citizens of Mexico, and have from \$2500.00 to \$10,000.00 in American gold with which to establish homes. They want to bring with them, their cattle, horses, and agricultural implements.

What encouragement can you give us, and can it be arranged to give them transportation from Larado to this place? Thanking you for an early reply, we are,
