5,000 Follow Funeral Cortège 3 As Senora Calles Is Laid to Rest

MEXICO CITY, Sunday.—In one of the most solemn and impressive ceremonies ever witnessed in the Mexican capital, Senora Calles, wife of the former president of Mexico, General Plutarco Elias Calles, was buried here today.

Besides the official funeral party, more than 5,000 persons dropped in line behind the cortège to form a mile-long procession to follow the body of the 27-year wife of Mexico's "strong man" to its final resting-place. She died on Friday from a recurrence of a brain malady which was thought to have been cured following an operation in the United States last summer.

Automobiles in double line made up the official cortège, while eight trucks were required to carry the mountain of wreaths and flowers that bespoke the nation's tribute. With the rush of

mourners to purchase flowers and wreaths yesterday, hardly a blossom was left in Mexico City today, with prices beyond the level of the boom years.

The entire diplomatic corps, as well as the highest members of officialdom and the ranking members of the army, had prominent places in the procession.

Senora Calles, daughter of a lifelong friend of General Calles, underwent a delicate brain operation in Boston last summer after being rushed across the continent by special train by her husband. It was thought she was steadily recovering since that time, but a relapse set in several days before her death, and she sank rapidly. She and General Calles were married two years ago.
