Unless otherwise expressly agreed, the purchaser will furnish and construct all foundations for all the machinery covered by these specifications.

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION.

The engine frame is of the enclosed dust-proof type, requiring for a foundation a simple block of concrete and pedestal for the outboard bearing. The metal throughout the entire engine, including the base or main frame, is well distributed and of an even reliable thickness, reinforced where necessary, to properly meet all regular or undue strains. Those parts which receive the full force due to the action of the engine, are carefully reinforced.

**ENGINE
FRAME**

The cylinder and cylinder head are made from a carefully selected mixture of charcoal iron, close grained, and are proportioned to carry, with a liberal factor of safety, the maximum strains to which they will be subjected. The cylinder walls are made double, providing a space for cooling water.

CYLINDER

The fuel is injected by a pump into the combustion chamber, and the combustion chamber is water jacketed.

**COMBUS-
TION
CHAMBER**

Ignition is by means of the heat of compression in connection with the self-contained heat in the combustion chamber. Starting is accomplished by means of compressed air furnished by the compressor and receiver starting equipment heretofore mentioned.

IGNITION

Inlet to and exhaust from the cylinder takes place through ports in the cylinder walls controlled by the movement of the piston.

PORTS

The crankshaft is of the center crank type, forged from a solid steel billet, accurately machined to size and polished.

**CRANK
SHAFT**

The main bearings are of the "ring oiling" type. They are fitted with heavy cast iron liners with bearing surfaces of a high grade babbitt. These liners may be adjusted or replaced without removing the flywheel, crankshaft, or upper base.

BEARINGS

The connecting rod is of forged open hearth steel, of ample cross section with a liberal margin of safety for taking care of any strain which may be applied. The piston end carries a bushing of high grade bearing bronze, so arranged that it can not work loose. The crank end of the rod is of the T form with the box and cap securely fastened by means of large bolts. The box and cap are made of bronze, babbitt lined, which forms an exceptionally rugged bearing. The cap is provided with a wick oil distributor that is held in contact with the crank pin by means of springs.

**CONNECT-

The piston is of the simple trunk type with a suitable number of cast iron spring piston rings. It is of unusual length, preventing wear at the top and bottom of the piston and remaining true in the cylinder. The piston pin is very large, of high grade steel, hardened and ground to exact size.

PISTON

The governor is of the centrifugal type, controlling the amount of fuel injected into the combustion chamber and gives a very accurate regulation by determining the amount of each charge of fuel in exact proportion to the load being carried.

GOVERNOR

As above mentioned, the main bearings are provided with "ring oilers." A large oil cistern under each bearing carries the oil supply. A mechanical "force feed" oil pump has "sight feeds" leading to the cylinder, piston pin and crank pin. Each feed of the oil pump may be adjusted as desired, and stops automatically when the engine is shut down. All lubricating oil reservoirs may be filled while the engine is in operation. The engine is also provided with an oil circulating system which returns the excess oil into the lubricating system.

**LUBRICATING
SYSTEM**

The engine will operate successfully on petroleum oils and distillates ranging in gravity from 44 degree B. down to the crude and fuel oils of 24 degree B. or lower. The particular oil to be used is to be subject to the builder's approval.

FUELS

The engine will be placed on a test block in our factory and subjected to a full rated Brake Horse Power test run, and all adjustments properly made before shipment.

TEST

All outside unfinished surfaces of the engine will be thoroughly filled, rubbed smooth and given a substantial color coat and varnish coat before shipping from the factory. All bright surfaces will be properly protected from corrosion for shipment.

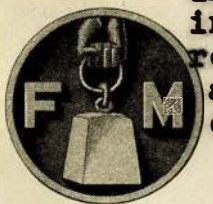

The Engine specified herein shall be tested by the Company at its factory before shipment and the Company guarantees said Engine shall develop **180** actual horsepower at such test. **HORSE-POWER**

When preparations are complete, ready for such erection, and at the request of the Purchaser, the Company shall furnish a competent Engineer at \$ ~~XXXXX~~ a day and expenses at the ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ expense, who shall superintend the erection of the machinery and do all work requiring skilled labor. The Purchaser shall erect the proper and necessary foundations and buildings immediately upon the arrival of such machinery and shall furnish all needed common labor, cartage and materials necessary for such erection and operation, rendering at all times friendly and needed assistance to said Engineer to facilitate such erection and operation. **ERECTION**

When properly installed the Company guarantees that at a test to be conducted at the time and in the manner hereinafter set forth, the machinery herein specified will operate successfully as follows: **GUARANTEE OF DUTY UPON TEST**

These engines will run on a fuel consumption of 0.42 pounds of approved fuel oil per brake horse power at full rated load on the engine.

These engines will operate for 1,000 rated horse power hours on a consumption of one gallon of new unused lubricating oil of an approved grade.

The foregoing guarantees are hereinafter designated and referred to as Guarantees of **TEST** Duty.

The test shall be made only if requested by the Purchaser, and if so requested shall consist of ~~two~~ days' operation thereof. The said test shall be conducted at the expense of the Purchaser, by the Engineer of the Company, who shall have entire charge thereof. The Purchaser shall furnish the load necessary for such test, also a careful and competent Engineer and other labor, if required, also fuel, water, waste, lights, and other incidentals needed for a proper test, rendering at all times friendly and needed assistance. The Engineer of the Company shall instruct the Purchaser's Engineer in regard to the proper management and operation of the machinery. The Engineer of the Purchaser and all other help shall be under the direction of the Engineer of the Company. During erection and such test the Engineer of the Company shall be considered to be the agent of the Purchaser, and his use and possession of such machinery shall be considered to be the use and possession of the Purchaser.

If at the end of said ~~two~~ days' test the machinery successfully operates in accordance with the said Guarantees of Duty hereinabove set forth, the Purchaser shall give to the Engineer of the Company a written acknowledgment that a successful test has been made, demonstrating that said machinery will operate successfully as provided in said Guarantees of Duty. Should the Engineer of the Company be required to remain longer than the period of such test, thru any fault of the Purchaser, the Purchaser shall pay the extra time of such Engineer, at the rate of \$ **10.00** per day and all expenses.

If at the end of such test, or at such time as the Company claims that said machinery has operated as provided in said Guarantee of Duty, the Purchaser fails or refuses to give such written acknowledgment that a successful test has been made, then the Purchaser shall immediately notify the Company at its office in **Los Angeles**, by registered letter, in what particulars the Purchaser claims said machinery to be defective or deficient, within said Guarantees of Duty, and the Company shall have a reasonable time after the receipt of such notification from the Purchaser, to remedy such defects or deficiencies claimed to exist. If it shall appear to be beyond the power of the Company to make the machinery perform according to said Guarantees of Duty within a reasonable time, then the Company shall remove the machinery, at no expense to the Purchaser, within a reasonable time, after giving thirty days' notice to the Purchaser, the Company having refunded to the Purchaser all purchase money paid thereon, whereupon all obligations and liability of either of the parties hereto to the other shall cease and determine and this agreement shall thereby become null and void.

The failure of the Purchaser to notify the Company of claimed defects or deficiencies as above provided within ten days after the completion of said test shall constitute an acknowledgment that said machinery has operated successfully at said test in strict accordance with said Guarantees of Duty.

It is understood that said Guarantees of Duty are specifically limited to the operation of said machinery at a test conducted by the Engineer of the Company at the time and in the manner above set forth and that if no test be requested by the Purchaser within ten days after said machinery is put in operation, or if such test cannot be properly conducted thru any fault of the Purchaser, then said Guarantees of Duty shall be null and void and the Company not bound thereby, and said machinery shall then be considered accepted by the Purchaser.

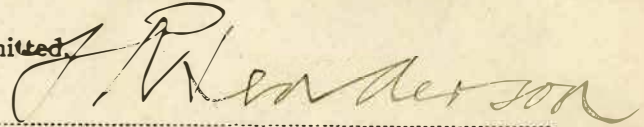
