I herewith offer my
services to the "Oregon Junta" for service
in any capacity what so ever.

I have had seven (7) years experience in
the United States Army, both as an Officer
and an enlisted man, my entire time in the
Army was with the "6th U.S. Cavalry" excepting
six months, when I was detailed with the
Motor Transport Corps, was discharged from
the service a 1st Lieutenant of Cavalry

I offer my services to you gentlemen,
not for personal gain nor glory, but,
for the best interests of Mexico.

My experience in the service, takes in
Cavalry, (operations of troops, mounted and dis-
mounted, in the field, training of Cavalry horses,
Machine guns, Motor Transportation, and the

duties of an Adjutant. I saw service in France during the late war with Germany also five years of Border Patrol along the Rio Grande.

Has offered a commission as Captain of Cavalry in the Polish Army, last September 1919, by the Minister of Military Affairs for the Republic of Poland, but refused as I had only come ^{out} of the hospital a short time before due to an operation on my leg.

In the event that you accept my services, advise me either by telegram or letter, full instructions.
