He served as President from December 1, 1924, to November 30, 1928, after successive careers as farm boy, country teacher, store keeper and finally revolutionist, and was known as "Mexico's Iron Man."

Calles rose to his country's highest office upon the fall in 1911 of Dictator-President Porfirio Diaz and was identified with other revolutionary generals whose program was one of land allotments, education, liberal labor laws and "no reelection."

## **EXILED 3 TIMES—**

He was a political foe of former President Lazaro Cardenas, who exiled him and three supporters to the United States in April, 1936, accusing Calles of "meddling in government affairs" and "criminal acts against the Mexican revolution."

Calles spent five years in California, returning to Mexico after President Avila Camacho took office. ## Caracas Falls in Revolt

WILLEMSTAD, Netherlands West Indies, Oct. 19.—The Laguarira radio in Venezuela said late today that President Medina has surrendered to young army officers after a revolt in which it was reported 32 persons were killed and many wounded. The Barquisimeto radio, loyal to Medina, had declared that the rebels were Fascists. Airplane passengers arriving yesterday from Caracas said the San Carlos and Maracay garrisons led the revolt, and 32 persons were killed. There has been no plane communications with Venezuela since yesterday.

CARACAS, Venezuela, Oct. 19.—Rebellious army leaders overthrew the Venezuelan government today and seized President Isaiah Medina.

The government toppled after a night and day of sporadic fighting during which the rebels seized control of all Caracas and the important military center of Maracay, 30 miles east of the capital.

Medina surrendered to the leaders of the military junta this afternoon, several hours after the insurrectionists had captured his predecessor, Lopez Contreras.

Led by a group of young army officers, the insurgents captured all the major army garrisons and central police headquarters in Caracas.

The rebels were reported using tanks against government troops at Maracay, where the important air base was said to have changed hands several times before Medina's forces surrendered.
