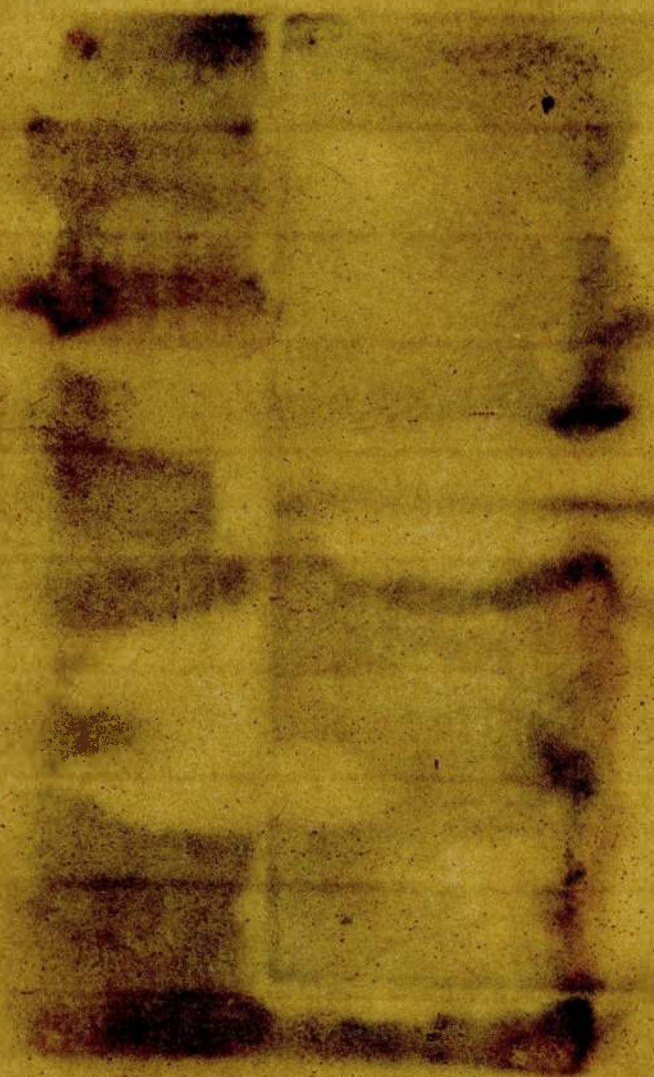

HOW CABLEGRAMS GO:— "VIA WESTERN UNION."



To the United States.

The Western Union Telegraph Company operates ten Trans-Atlantic Cables.

Cablegrams from Great Britain and France addressed to all destinations in the United States of America are despatched from London, Liverpool, or Paris, direct to New York; messages from Belgium and Holland are sent to the London cable terminal by direct Western Union wires from Antwerp and Brussels, and Amsterdam respectively, whilst messages from other European countries reach the Western Union Cables by direct connections from the chief cities of Europe.

Direct working is accomplished by recently developed apparatus which eliminates the laborious manual relay at intermediate cable stations of former days. In other words, by the Western Union System New York is brought as close to London and other important European cities, telegraphically speaking, as any suburban area. Boston, Mass. and Montreal, Quebec, are similarly linked up direct with London over one of the Trans-Atlantic cables by means of an entirely new type of apparatus recently installed.

From New York a network of telegraph lines radiates to the 25,000 offices maintained

by the Western Union in the United States. The following cities are connected with New York by direct wires giving instantaneous communication:—

To Canada and Newfoundland.

Direct wires to Montreal, Toronto and Winnipeg ensure an unsurpassed telegraph service. Exclusive connection with the Canadian National Telegraph system affords a rapid service to all other parts of the Dominion and to Newfoundland.

To Cuba and West Indies.

Cablegrams circulate over the Atlantic cables to New York, whence they are retransmitted by direct Western Union landline and cable circuits to Havana. Connections from Havana give unequalled telegraph service to the West Indies.

To Mexico.

Cablegrams are transferred from the Trans-Atlantic cables to a direct circuit running from the Western Union cable office in New York to the office of the Mexican Telegraph Company in Mexico City. These arrangements bring London within a few minutes reach of Mexico City. In addition, offices are maintained at Vera Cruz, Tampico, Puerto Mexico and Salina Cruz.

To Central America.

Direct connections in New York with associated companies serving all countries in Central America.

To South America.

Cablegrams to South America pass over the Atlantic cables to New York, where they are retransmitted by direct cable circuit in the Western Union office to Buenos Aires, Rio de Janeiro, Santos and Pernambuco, thus affording an excellent service to these points and offices in the interior.

To Australasia.

The Atlantic-Pacific route.—Australia and New Zealand can be reached by Western Union service through the medium of the cables of the Pacific Cable Board, an exceptionally fast service being assured to all parts of Australasia over the new permalloy cables of the two systems.
