Dear Dr. Griffith:

We are writing to you at the request of Mrs. -
Fred Zengel, who has visited our offices and given us your -
name.

We understand that you are interested in sub-
scribing to our quarterly journal, Historia Mexicana, and in -
acquiring a complete set of this publication. The price of the
latter is US \$ 38.50 which includes Nos. 1 to 38. A year's -
subscription is \$US 5.00 and will begin with No. 39 to appear
in January of 1961.

El Colegio de México has recently begun publi-
cation of a quarterly journal on international affairs, Foro
Internacional, which is designed to give the Spanish reader, -
that is, the public of Spain and of nineteen of the Latin Ame-
rican countries, an idea of their own problems and of those -
of the principle nations or regions of the world. These pro-
blems are not only of a juridical nature, but political, eco-
nomic, social and cultural as well.

We are sending you, under separate cover, a copy
of this journal which may be of interest to you and your collea-
gues. We are also anxious to have contributions: articles of
fifteen to thirty pages, for which we pay forty dollars; or -
book reviews, for which we pay ten to twenty dollars, according
to length. By these payments we do not pretend to acquire exclu-
sive literary rights, but only in Spanish. In this way, authors
who write in a language other than Spanish would be free to use
those same articles or book reviews for publication in other -
languages; conversely, we would be glad to consider for our -
journal such writings as may appear in a language other than -
Spanish.

El Colegio de México would also appreciate your
indicating to us the names and addresses of friends or collea-
gues whom you consider likely to be interested in collaborating
with us.
