
Dear Professor Cosio:

Dear President Cosio:

I am now in a position - somewhat belatedly I am afraid - to report on the status of the list of books you gave me when I was in Mexico which you reported had not up till then been received by El Colegio under our grant GA SS 59117. The situation is as follows:

- 1) A substantial number of the books have been shipped to El Colegio within the past two months.
- 2) The attached list indicates that:
 - (a) 14 titles are still open on this order and will be sent if and when available;
 - (b) a substantial number of titles on the list you gave me had been cancelled on the original order because they were known to be out of print.

We hope that it will be possible to secure all of the 14 titles mentioned under 1) above and, should any balance of funds remain after closing out this order, we will be glad to arrange for it to be sent to El Colegio for additional purchases by the Center's library.

Dear Dr. Thompson:

May I acknowledge your good letter of October 3er., regarding the list of books I gave you here in Mexico.

The position, indeed, has changed since that time, and, as you say, a substantial number of the books have been received by El Colegio. Of the 14 titles still open on this order, one, n° 286: Allen, Western Civilisation has been received. As to the four titles which you say were not ordered by the Foundation, 2 were in your list: under n° 45 (II) Jessup, Parliamentary Democracy and under 208 (II) Spykman, America's Strategy. We have not interest in securing n° 37 (II), Nicholson's, The Congress of Vienna, as we already have it in our library.

Anyhow, the situation is clear enough now: there are only 13 titles pending, which we are looking forward to receive soon.
