Country, and to your
Country, and to Humanity
and God - to give you
this message of President
Carranza,

message from Gen Rogales
to you. all I ask of you is
to protect my "name" the world

Venustiano Carranza:-

I have come to ask you in the name of justice, and to put the Government on the guard, and to quiet the false rumors regarding my assassination:-

Will you kindly write to General Alvaro Obregon, and tell him that my Chief of Cabinet staff conspired to assassinate me, The one who fired the shot that killed me, was, Ignacio Bonillas, General Nogales tried to defend me, Juan Barragan told Bonillas to shoot Nogales Bonillas shot and killed Nogales first, then shot me.
