I am glad to inform you that general editing has been completed on all of the Conference papers, and that the checking of footnotes and copy editing will commence next month. Publication of the English version of the papers by the Columbia University Press is expected in the spring of 1967.

I wish to thank all of you for your cooperation in reading the English translations and making revisions. I have made a few corrections for style and clarity, but the text is essentially that which each of you reviewed. In order to expedite publication, I propose that I read the galley and page proofs without sending them out to you for checking. If, however, any author wishes to read and revise his proofs please let me know as soon as convenient, and we shall be glad to send them to you.

We should like to publish brief, one-paragraph biographical notes for all authors, similar to those that are printed at the end of Social Science Research on Latin America, edited by Charles Wagley. We have received such notes from Messrs. Cámara Barbachano, Escobar, Flores Olea, and Ianni. It would be greatly appreciated if the other authors would please send us biographical notices for inclusion in the volume.

Please keep us informed of any changes in your addresses or affiliations, so that books and offprints may be sent to the correct address next spring.
