Your Excellency:

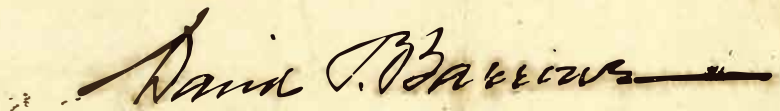
May I bring to your attention the rather unusual work at this University of a young lady from Mexico, Miss Blanca Otero?
