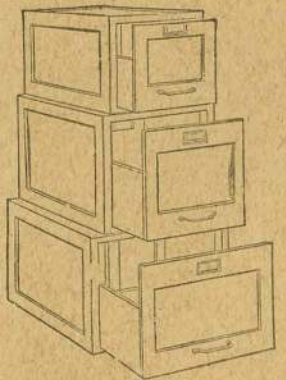

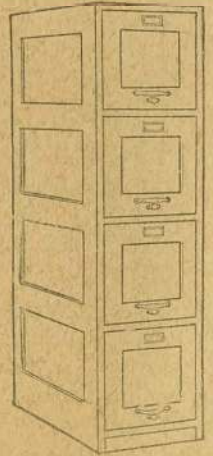

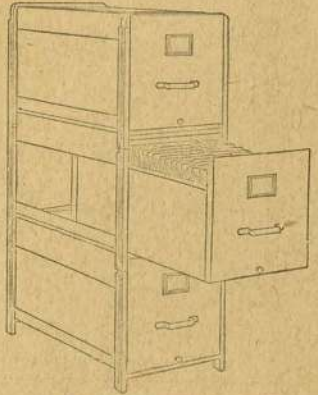
"Y and E" Drawer Style Wood Transfer Cases

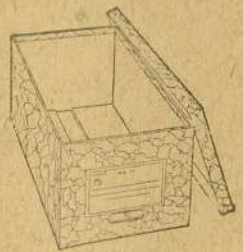
"Y and E" 4-drawer Wood Transfer Cases

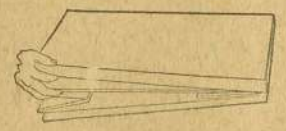

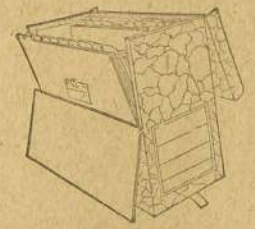
"Y and E" Style "A" Set-up Transfer Cases
