

SIMILARITIES
Migrants as merely cannon fodder: forced recruitment and of Central American origin
Northeast States, within the migration route towards Gulf
War between CDG and Zetas after trial and reduction of sentence of Osiel Cárdenas Guillén
Without due process from authorities (break of the chain of custody, incorrect handling of the bodies, different versions by authorities)
Zetas Territory (CDG constricted to Reynosa and Matamoros, the rest +/- in Zeta control)

Part of a systemic process (SFI looks like a one more case amongst SF II, NSA 20110408)	Specific event, although within an exchange of bodies and narco-banners in the northeast, (Document of Homeland security (NSA 20120504)
In other words, the appearance of 72 migrants as a coincidence after the survival of 3 (as we mentioned in <i>State of Neglect</i> , 2017), but most likely would had add to the hundreds of disappearances in the San Fernando region (i.e. Guillén, Torres & Turati, 2018)	
Diffusive motive: migrants extortion, hunt down of the rivalry group, routs destruction, forced recruitment?	Clear motive: catching public opinion through extreme brutality (Either to threaten a rival group (if Zetas were the perpetrators) or to included/associated them (if perpetrated by the CDG or CDS)
Clear perpetrator: Los Zetas	Unknown perpetrator: CDG, CDS or Los Zetas?
Zetas at their finest, 2010	CDG+CDS attacking Zetas positions, 2012
International Scandal, remembered every year	Reduced scandal
