Washington's Peace, Jefferson's Democracy and
Lincoln's Advice.

1. World peace by protecting labor and capital by an International price agreement on all staple commodities.

God will regulate the supply and demand.

2. Utilities to be equally and jointly owned individually and governmentally by gradually using the government's aid to double the capacity. (United we stand. Divided we fail).

3. Banking and postal deposit systems to co-operate by making this government self-supporting and liable for all money on deposit. (Co-operation is peace).

4. Insurance and tax to be collected by one system.

(To relieve profiteering politically and industrially).

5. Agriculture should not be interfered with by the lower industrial and educational systems. (God's industry).

6. Medical men of talent to be privately or governmentally paid to keep the people in health. (Health is wealth).

7. Judges, Professors, Attorneys and school faculties to co-operate in preserving peace by the higher educational knowledge. An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure in litigation and divorce.

8. No war, except if invaded, or by a vote of the people. (Hell is war).

9. Suffrage for the patriotic wife. (God's law).

10. Honesty in diplomacy. (To deceive will ruin you.)

11. No evils licensed. (God's will).

12. Free Speech. (The Constitution).

13. Unity by equal justice. (God Himself).
