Thank you for your letter of January 24 (enclosing a draft for \$ 724.70), in which you say that should we require all or part of the Balance of \$ 1,495.30 during the remaining period fo the grant, you would be glad to make the necessary payment upor receipt from us of a revised budget.

I am afraid that due to the faulty presentation of the budget submitted in my letter of December 17, a misunderstanding has arisen, and if so, I would like to clarify it. As you may remember, the total amount of the grant was \$ 13,880, to be spent as follows:

Except the item for materials, the other two were, we may say, fixed payments, and consequently were to be divided in four semesters of equal amont each, that is to say, \$ 3,220 for each semester.

That was the reason why the first budget for July Ist. to December 31, 1955, amounted to \$ 4,220: \$ 3,220 to cover the two items of Mr. Cosío Villegas' stipend and research and editorial work, plus \$ 1,000 for materials. Having received in one payment the whole of item "materials", we should have presented for each of the following three budgets the same amount of \$ 3,220.

In presenting the budget for the second semester (January

Ist.-June 30, 1956), we made the mistake, however, of applying for the sum of \$4,220, 3,220 for Mr. Cosío Villegas' stipend, research and editorial work, and once more \$1,000 for materials. The next budget for the second semester of 1956, was correct: \$3,220 for Mr. Cosío Villegas' stipend, research and editorial work. Since we had received \$2,000 for materials and we had no right to use more than \$1,000, our budget for the fourth and final semester should have been presented as follows:
