The tall boys are our seven sons. The little fellows are our sons-in-law.

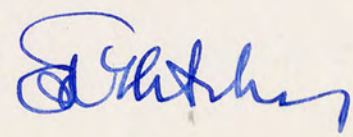
I am more than happy to send this picture of the family to you and I am asking that you send me your photograph and autograph in remembrance of several happy trips together and a friendship that will last thru life.
