## Memorandus for Mr. Fahs, from Daniel Cosio Villegas:

- 1) I am ashemed to find out so late that in figuring out the cost of the Seminar on modern History of México I made a mistake both as to the number of people involved and as to their respective payments.
- I imagined six people were enough, while I am now convinced that ten is the proper number, although from the point of view of cost I discard two, for the Bank of Mexico very kindly offered me send to the Seminar two members of its Research Department, as full time workers and under no other directions but mine, the Bank paying them their full salaries.
- I imagined that I could secure two senior fellows to work helf-time (from 9 a. m. to 2 p. m.) for \$ 52.00 a month; I am now convinced that \$ 70.00 would be the minimum. On the contrary, junior echolars can be secured at \$ 35.00, but as I now believe we need six of them instead of four, the whole cost will increase.
- 4) The cost as I now figure it out is as follows:
  - 3 researchers, at \$ 70 a month each, for the whole two-years period ----- \$ 5,640.00
  - 6 assistants, at \$ 35 a month, for the whole 5,040.00 Total ---- \$ 10,650.00
- 6! I wonder whether you think it possible an extension of the grant up to that amount.
