DESCRIPCIÓN: Recortes de prensa del periódico "Los Ángeles Times" del domingo 10 de septiembre de 1939, que reproduce en toda la plana un mapa de Europa. Se titula "Save this map! It show the theater of War", al pie trae instrucciones para guardar el mapa y poder seguir el curso de la guerra.

HOW TO PRESERVE THIS MAP

Use a good heavy-weight cardboard (lined chip board is best) and either library or flour paste. You may either cover the entire back of the map with paste or just tip the edges, but when rubbing the map onto the board be sure to cover it with another paper to avoid smearing the color ink. If a very heavy board is not available it is best to mount a sheet of paper on the back of the board thus preventing warping of board when paste dries.

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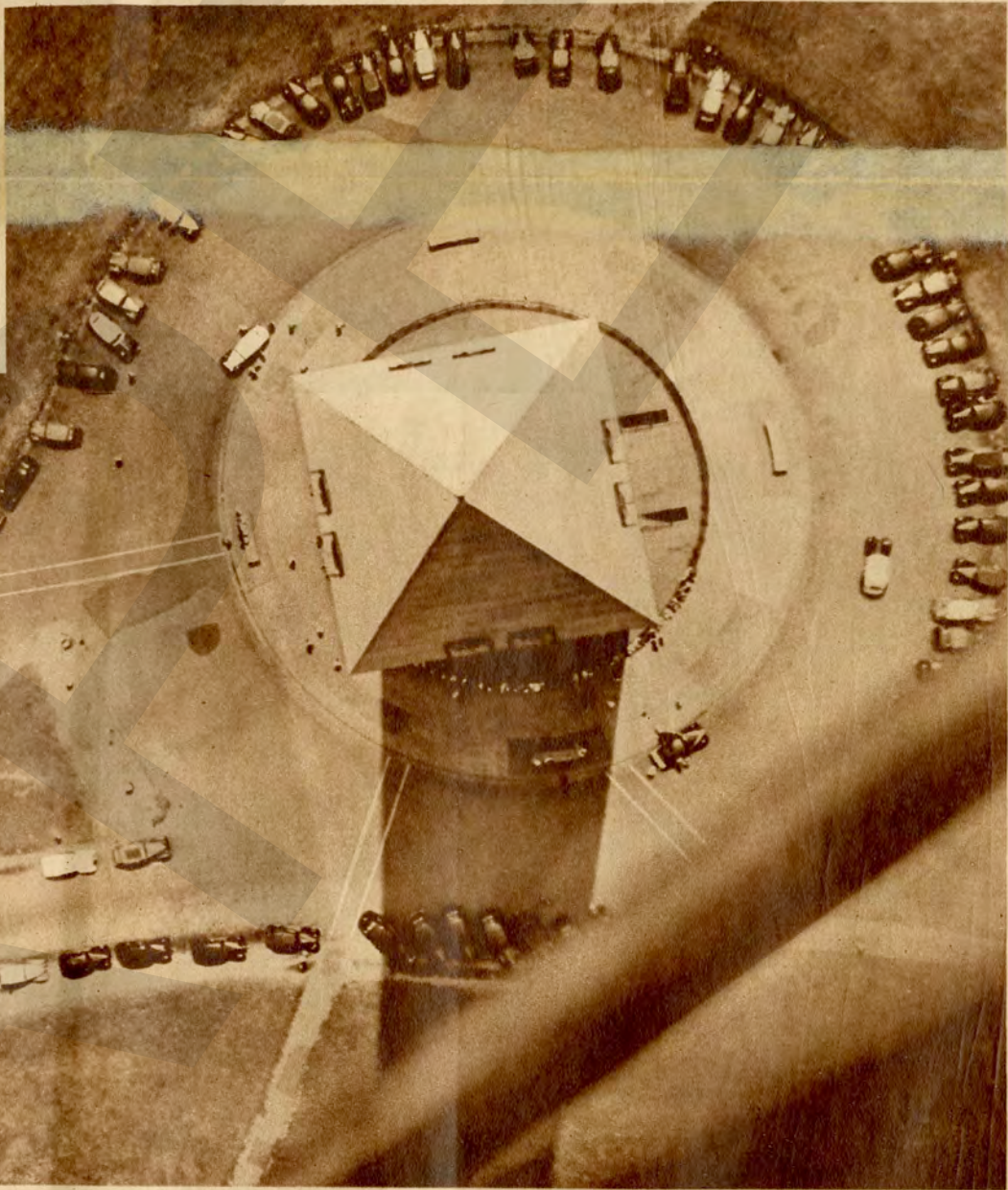
