Muy respetable Sr. presidente:


Me permito el altísimo honor de enviarle la presente, para ofrecerle mis servicios como interprete del Idioma Ingles.



I hope to see you soon. There is an excursion that is leaving here for Mexico City to attend the ceremony of inaugurating your new President, General Obregon. The purpose of this affair is to cement the relations between Mexico and the United States in the bonds of true fellowship and friendship. I hope this can be done. You know Mexico has no better friend than the United States. Our new President, Honorable Warren G. Harding, is a splendid man of high ideals, lofty purposes, and whose sole ambition is to be of genuine service to the whole of mankind. I believe your new President, the distinguished General who heads the destinies of your Republic, appreciates this, and that these two gentlemen will get together for the benefit of the people of your country, as well as for the people of our country. It is the prayer of all well-meaning persons that peace reign supreme in your country, and that you people be given an opportunity to develop its wonderful natural resources.

I wonder if you could do me this favor: I want two Mexican hats, those worn by the vaqueros. I have seen them in your big stores. I would like to have them to use when I appear in parades. Also, I would be pleased with a small serape, of red and bluish green color. Any cost attached to this I would gladly pay.
