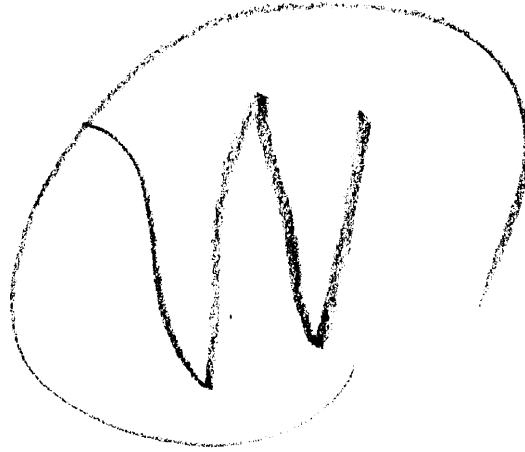
Mexico Seizes Japanese Oil Firm
