My dear Dr. Vizcarra.

"His Excellency the Governor of Arizona is in a position to accomplish a good deed; there is nothing to prevent him from doing it. Respectfully begging from him the grace of pardon for the Mexican, tofor Pedro Dominguez. I am availing myself of this oportunity to reiterate to His Excellency the assurance of my most distinguished appreciation."

The provisions of the State os Arizona make it impossible for the Governor to commute the sentence of any condemned man or to parole or pardon any prisoner, until such time as the State Board of pardons and Paroles has made such recommendation to the Executive. I make this statement so that you will clearly understand, contrary to the views expressed in your letter and quoted above, that I am not in a position to commute the sentence of Pedro Dominguez or to grant him a pardon. When the State Board of Pardons and Paroles at a meeting held on the 11th day of this month refused to make any recommendation to me in behalf of this man. the case was closed and beyond review or action by me. I desire also to call your attention to another misstatement of fact, which I know to be unintentional, which appears in the except from your letter. Pedro Dominguez. is not Mexican, but an American, having been bord in this country, and is answerable to its laws. While I thoroughlyunderstan your position and the motives which actuate your appeal to me in behalf of a member of your own race, there is no way, legally or atherwise by which I could render the service you ask at my hands. Dominguez pleaded guilty to what the evidence in his case shows to have been an unprovoked killing. of all the letters and telegrams in this behalf received by me, none have set forth the claim that he is innocent or does not merit the punishment imposed on him by the Court.;
